



Eye Protection

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is your last line of defence ensure you use it!

- Always wear your eye protection where required in designated areas
- Choose the right eye protection for the job where there is a hazard from:
 - Heat - use safety glasses/face shields appropriate for the temperature and glare from furnaces and molten metal
 - UV Radiation – use appropriately shaded welding helmets or goggles when welding or oxy-cutting
 - Chemicals – this could require non-ventilated goggles and face shield, check what is required in the Safety Data Sheet
 - Flying particles – safety glasses and face shield are a minimum when grinding
- Keep your eye protection in good condition and store them correctly
- Replace faulty or badly scratched eye protection
- Think of passers-by who may also be affected – erect a screen or barricade
- If something harmful enters your eye seek first aid attention immediately
