

Bradken operates a global Environmental Management System (EMS) which complies with the requirements of ISO14001:2015 for the following scope:

The scope of the Bradken EMS at each manufacturing and warehouse facility covers the environmental obligations, aspects and impacts of the assets, activities and services managed, controlled and influenced by that facility. This includes the following activities:

- The provision and manufacture of (iron and steel casting; metal fabrication and machining; ceramic and rubber composite production; corrosion, erosion and wear resistant overlay production), repair, refurbishment, modification, construction, maintenance and supply of capital equipment and consumable parts for the mining, quarrying, construction, rail freight, transportation, oil sands, power generation, steel making, smelting, sugar, cement and general engineering industries.
- The processing and recycling of iron and steel waste materials for domestic and export trade purposes.
- The production and supply of foundry consumable products to internal and external customers.

The scope of the Bradken EMS does not include product design and sales activities.
